#### Developments in Institute during 2011 -12

- AICTE approved BE (Petro Chemical Engg.) and M.Tech. (E&C) and have been started w.e.f. July 2011. Also AICTE increased intake of MCA from 90 to 120. SATI is first institute in MP to start BE (Petro Chemical Engg.) Programme BE (Chemical Engg) part time course has also been started from July 2011.
- AICTE has accorded the permission to setup SATI as QIP (Quality Improvement Programme) centre for Ph.D. in 5 streams of Engg. & Technology w.e.f. 2011-12 with 2 seats each in Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, CSE, IT. SATI is 2<sup>nd</sup> institute in M.P. to get this QIP centre for Ph.D.
